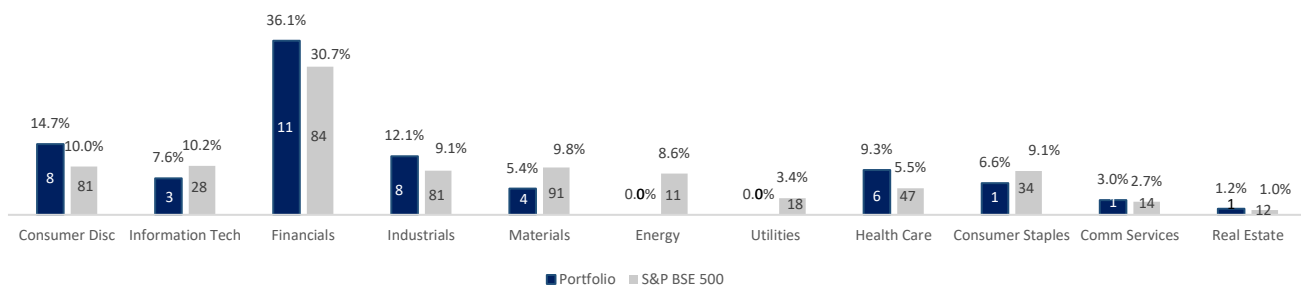

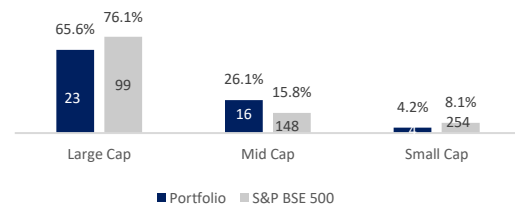

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Performance Review

The portfolio was up 2.1% in July 2023, underperforming the benchmark by 188bps. The key contributors include Ajantha Pharma(+14.7%), ICICI Bank (+6.8%), and Cipla (+16.7%), whereas Nestle (-1.5%), HDFC Bank (-3.0%), and Cholamandalam Investment (-0.8%) were the key detractors.

Year-to-date, the portfolio was up 10.2%, underperforming the benchmark by 83bps. The key contributors include Cholamandalam Investment (+57.0%), Persistent Systems (+23.9%), and CG Power & Industrial Solutions (+49.5%), whereas Ambuja Cements (-11.1%), Dixon Technologies (-28.1%), and HDFC Bank (+2.6%) were the key detractors.

Market Review

In July 2023, S&P BSE 500 TR index was up 4.0%. S&P BSE 100 LargeCap was up 3.2%, S&P BSE 150 MidCap up 5.9%, and S&P BSE 250 SmallCap up 7.6%.

In July 2023, foreign institutional investors (FIIs) were net buyers to the tune of US\$4.1bn, while net selling by domestic institutional investors (DIIs) was US\$0.3bn. For the month, the Rupee depreciated by 0.2% while the 10-year G-Sec yields rose marginally from 7.12% to 7.18%. Commodities rallied, with Brent and S&P GSCI Industrial Metals Index up 13.4% and 6.3%, respectively.

For the month, Utilities, Energy and Real Estate outperformed, while Consumer Staples, Information Technology, and Financials underperformed. Large caps have underperformed mid and small caps this month, while State-owned entities outperformed their private peers.
