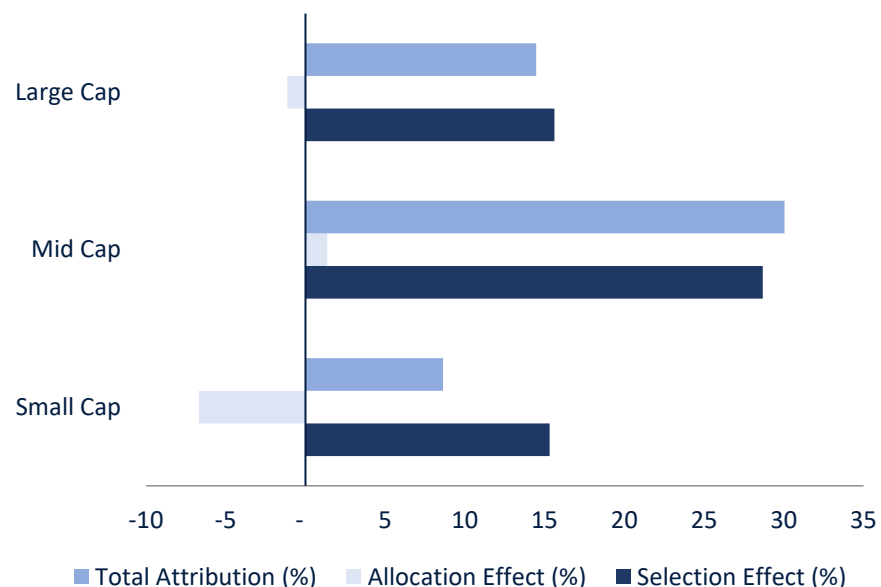

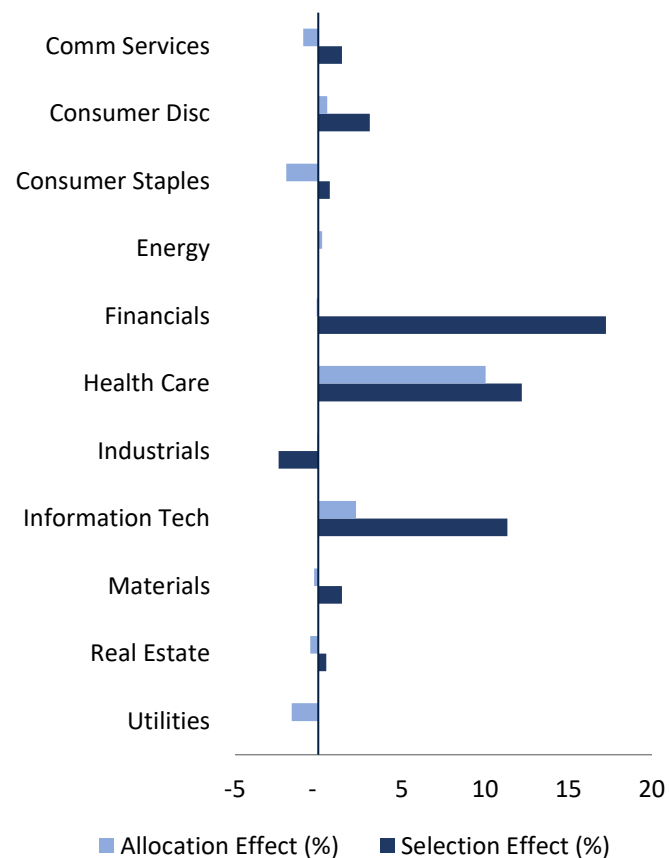

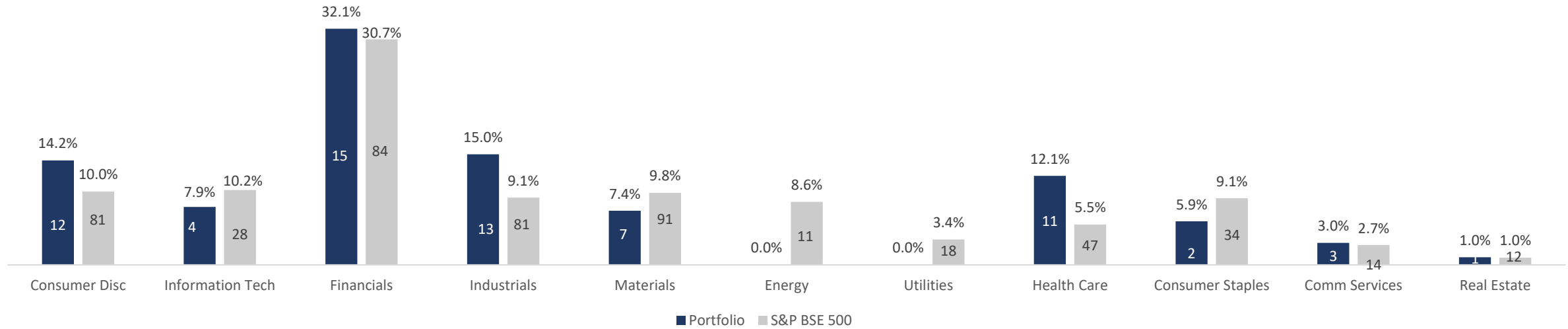

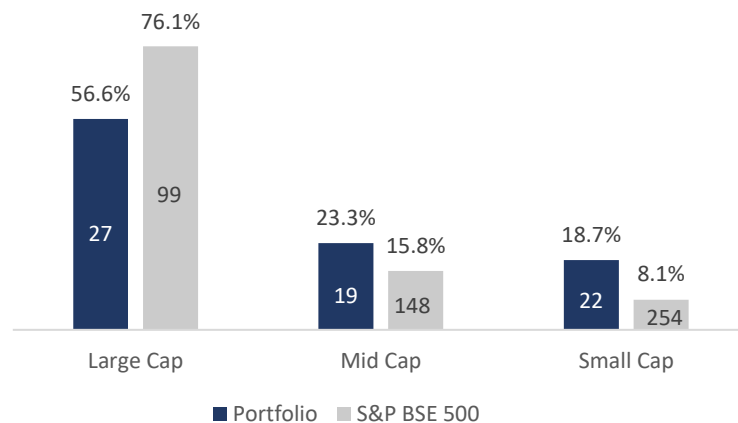
Portfolio Composition
